Call to open- Motion by Heather Perkins and seconded by Micki Carlson.

Treasurer's Report- \$197,000 after \$26,450 for London Trip. Motion as read by Michael Fleetwood and seconded by Michele Gilbert.

New Business-

- **London (payments)-** 84 students, 21 fans, 4 self-paid chaperones, and 3 chaperones paid for by band to ensure correct numbers. (117 total)
- **5K-** Has been moved to Spring semester. Moving the venue from The Rock due to runners not liking the course. Possibly the reason for low sign ups. \$110 for company to mark new track, possibly use Sam Smith if it's available. Ask Jarrod to reach out to the city coordinator.
- **Chaperones-** More help needed for practices and games outside of the core group that has been volunteering. Possibly offer incentives of some type? Will push for more help in emails.
- **Fundraisers-** Discount card sales starting 8/30. Possible incentives for most sold?
 - o **Rockathon-** Deadline for sponsors is September 30. Incentives for most sold/every \$100 gets one throw at dunk tank during lock in. Other possibilities are Kobe with Kobito for top seller and popsicles and Gatorade for top section. Lock in date is November 11.
 - o **Boston Butts-** September
 - o **Candles-** October 17-28
 - o **Silent Auction-** During Winter concert.
 - o **Snap Raise-** Possibly in Spring. 80% goes to band.
- **Needs coming up-** Water, sodas, Little Debbies for Rockathon and after competitions. Kroger is donating water to the band.
- **Lettering-** Student needs to participate in 2 major fundraisers in order to letter. i.e., Rockathon, Discount Cards and Boston Butt.
- **Show Shirts-** mock ups should be ready within a few days and then will be ordered.
