Treasurer's Report- Read by Michele Gilbert. August balance \$181,264.16 with an income of \$87,678.15. Expenses were \$112,711.60 (which includes 3rd London deposit of \$92,000). August ending balance is 156,230.71. Motion to accept as read by Kristy Underwood and seconded by Heather Perkins.

New Business-

- **London payments-** Payments due today for September

- **5K (Music on the Run)** Moved to February or March.

- **Chaperones-** Need to send out reminders that there's no free entrance for anyone unless volunteering and wearing lanyard. We've had a problem with people trying to claim they're with the band to access the game for free and it was expressed to us by the gate attendants so we can address it.
