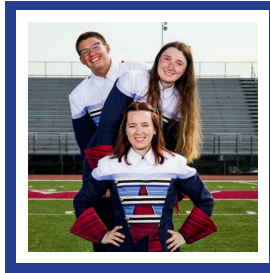

\* Courses vary depending on earned credits

- Dual Enroll available in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- Not displayed: 10-12<sup>th</sup> graders can sign up for classes at the Bartow County College & Career Academy (BCCCA) to complete a pathway or certification.
- Students who enroll in 3+ courses in the same elective pathway can earn a cord for graduation
